

Notice of Close of Regular Voter Registration and Option for Late Registration

Notice is hereby given that regular* registration for elections to be held on May 5, 2026 will close at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 2026. To register to vote, or to update your name, address, or other voter information, submit the voter registration application to the Sheridan County Election Office, 100 W. Laurel Ave., Plentywood, MT 59254. You may obtain an application by calling the Elections Office at 406-765-3403 or by going to www.sheridancountymt.gov. The application must be signed before being submitted to the Elections Office.

* If you miss this regular registration deadline, you may still late-register for and vote in the election by showing up at the Elections Office up to 12:00 p.m. Monday, May 4, 2026 and on Election Day. Between noon and close of business on the day before Election Day (Monday, May 4, 2026), you can complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the local Elections Office on Election Day to vote.

The following school districts are scheduled to hold a May 5, 2026 election; however, their elections may be cancelled if trustee positions are not contested and there are no other ballot issues to vote on: Medicine Lake School District, Plentywood School District, Westby School District.

All active and inactive**electors who reside in the school district holding an election may vote in that district's election.

Plentywood School District Election-Mail Ballot Election

**For districts holding a mail ballot election, ballots will be automatically mailed to registered electors with an active status between April 15, 2026 and April 20, 2026.
