



## **Notice of Primary Election Recount and Cancellation of Post Election Audit**

The purpose of a recount is to provide accurate results of the votes cast in a close election. A recount is an administrative process described in Title 13, Chapter 16, Montana Code Annotated (MCA). The only automatic recounts are if there is a tie vote. Any other recount must be petitioned for by the unsuccessful candidate or by an elector for an unsuccessful ballot issue.
